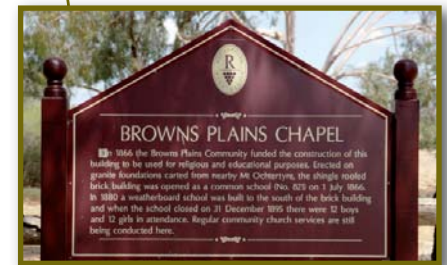
## THE HUMPTY DOOS

(Approx 40kms)

# THE HUMPTY DOOS (Approx 40kms)

A great ride on country back roads (small bit on the Murray Valley Highway) that incorporates the set of hills known as the Humpty Doos .

LHS = Left Hand Side      RHS = Right Hand Side

Approx Kms	Comments
0	Commence the ride from the Rutherglen Wine Experience car park left towards Chiltern.
1.7	Pass Anderson Winery (RHS) renowned for its sparkling wines.
3	Take the Cornishtown Rd turn off to the left. (Cornishtown Rd is a lovely winding country lane)
13.4	Turn left at the Old Howlong Rd intersection ⇒ Proceed over the Humpty Doos, a great set of hills where you can go as hard or as easy as you like ⇒ Good views at the highest point and note the Wodonga Hills in the distance on the RHS.
18	Morris Wines vineyard on the LHS.
18.5	Browns Plain Chapel on the RHS ⇒ The Browns Plain Community funded the construction of this building in 1866 for religious and educational purposes.
18.8	Turn right at the Murray Valley Highway ⇒ Please note that this is a main road so riders should maintain single file along this short stretch.
20.2	Turn left at the Chiltern Howlong Rd.
21.5	Morris Winery and home vineyard on the LHS.
23.2	Turn left at the 'T' intersection (Goramadda Rd) ⇒ Proceed along this road past the Howlong turn off to the right. (The small town of Howlong is approx a 4km detour off this route)
25.1	Goramadda Olives on the LHS. (Goramadda Olives have won prestigious awards for their extra virgin olive oils and olive products. Open Fri – Mon, 10.00am to 5.00pm)
27.4	The House at Mt Prior on the LHS. (A stately manor circa 1880s that is now a B&B, serving lunches and dinners by appointment)
27.8	Mt Prior Vineyard on the LHS. (You can drop in 7 days a week to sample some of Rutherglen's great wines).
29.8	Terravinia Vineyard and the Still House B&B. (The vineyard is not open to the public but the beautiful old Still House B&B overlooking an anabranch of the Murray River is a perfect romantic getaway for couples)
31.5	Proceed straight ahead at the Up River Road turn off.
39.8	Turn right at the Murray Valley Highway and proceed back into Rutherglen.
41.5	Finish your ride at the Rutherglen Wine Experience car park.
